



ISO has released the ISO 28000:2022 in last year, which replaces the old version from 2007. This International Standard specifies requirements for a security management system, including aspects relevant to the supply chain. It is applicable to all types and sizes of organizations (e.g., commercial enterprises, government or other public agencies and non-profit organizations) which intend to establish, implement, maintain and improve a security management system.

This second edition of ISO 28000 cancelled and replaced the first edition from 2007. The primary objective of the revision was to align the standard the Harmonized Structure (HS) laid out in the ISO Directives Annex SL ISO for Appendix 2 managements system standards in its latest version.



alignment makes the standard fully integratable and easy to use together with other managements systems standards like ISO 9001 quality on management or ISO 22301 for business continuity management. Aside of the alignment with the HS the main changes are:

- recommendations on principles have been added in clause 4 to provide for a better coordination with ISO 31000
- recommendations have been added in clause 8 for better consistency with ISO 22301 facilitating integration of requirements and recommendations of both standards into one holistic integrated and sustainable management system of the user. It now includes 1) security strategies, procedures, processes and treatments and 2) security plans.

If you are working in the supply chain industry production, including storage, distribution, transportation of goods (road, rail, sea and air), etc., we highly recommend your organization to apply ISO 28000 Certification as it can contribute directly to the business capability and credibility of an organization and to its resilience. Building Value Through ISO 20400 Sustainability Procurement A standard In Relationship with ISO 26000, ISO 14064 & ISO 50001

In order to deliver sustainable benefits, be more competitive and enhance the contribution of organizational procurement to organizational objectives, as well as prevent financial, environmental and reputational risk, many organizations adapt ISO 20400 verification recently.

ISO 20400 – "Guidelines for Sustainable Procurement" was developed in response to the increasing recognition of the importance of sustainable procurement practices. Sustainable procurement involves considering the environmental, social, and economic impacts of the goods and services being procured, as well as the impacts of the procurement process itself.

If your organization have been obtaining "ISO 26000 – Social Responsibility and Sustainable Development", "ISO 14064 – Greenhouse Gas Emissions Management System" or "ISO 50001 – Energy Management System", they may also consider attaining ISO 20400 as they are all interrelated and can be used in conjunction with each other.



ISO 20400 can be used to guide sustainable procurement practices that consider the environmental and social impacts of the goods and services being procured, while ISO 14064 can be used to measure and report on the greenhouse gas emissions associated with those goods and services. ISO 50001 can be used to manage energy consumption and reduce associated GHG emissions, while ISO 26000 can be used to ensure that social responsibility considerations are integrated into an organization's energy management practices.

The relationship among these standards is one of mutual reinforcement, where the adoption and implementation of one standard can support and enhance the adoption and implementation of others, leading to more sustainable and socially responsible practices.


