What is ESG Certification?

Our ESG Certification scheme is an assessment and verification of Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) practices within an organization according to the established criteria. The Certification granted to an organization can demonstrate her commitment to sustainability and responsible business practices.

Certification Application

Our ESG Certification is a 3-year certification cycle which include one Certification Audit and two Surveillance Visits. The methodologies include materiality assessment, document/record review, interview and site visits.

Certification Process

1. Client's enquiry and submit the application,
2. Client accept & sign Certification Contract
3. Materiality Assessment on ESG Reporting
4. Certification Audit → Non-Conformance and Corrective Plan
5. ESG Certificate granted with 3-year validity
6. Regular Surveillance Visit
7. Reassessment before Certificate Expires

ESG Specification:

Our ESG Certification refers to a set of criteria used to evaluate the sustainability and societal impact of an organization's operations. Below are the guidelines and standards for assessing and reporting on these factors.

Below is a total of 22 CRITERIA under the Certification. To qualify for the ESG Certification, applicant must fulfil: A minimum of 3 CRITERIA from each Aspect, (1) Environmental; (2) Social and (3) Governance.

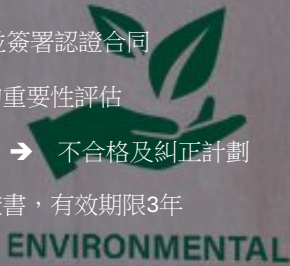

認證申請

我們的 ESG 認證為期 3 年，其中包括一次認證審核和兩次監督審核。審核當中包括重要性評估、文件/記錄審查、訪談和實地考察。

認證流程

1. 客戶詢問並提交申請
2. 客戶接受並簽署認證合同
3. ESG報告的重要性評估
4. 認證審核 → 不合格及糾正計劃
5. 獲頒ESG證書，有效期限3年
6. 監督審核
7. 證書到期前重新評估
